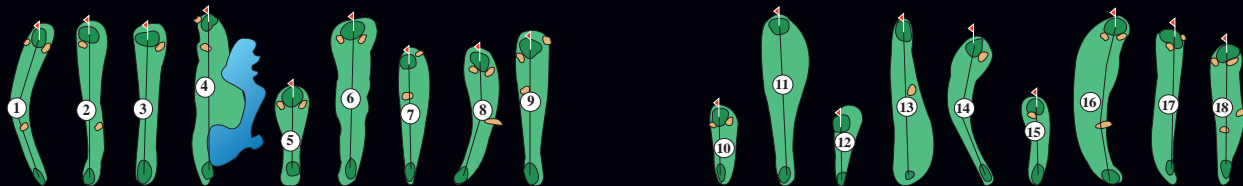
C.W. KOINER COURSE #1 – LOCAL RULES
USGA & The Following Local Rules Govern All Play

- **FLOOD CONTROL CHANNELS** are LATERAL WATER HAZARDS unless they are defined by yellow stakes, then they are WATER HAZARDS. A ball coming to rest on the opposite side of the channel is deemed to be in the channel. The concrete lining or a red line defines the boundary of the hazard.
- **NOTE:** When a ball is in the flood control channel it may not be played from the channel. Relief must be taken under Rule 26.
- **LAKES:** All lakes are lateral water hazards, (Rule 26). Boundaries defined by the water's edge unless otherwise marked.
- **OUT OF BOUNDS:** Fences and masonry walls bounding course. Paved cart path left side and behind #9 and behind #18 green. Inside of driving range left of #1 and #9 fairways. White stakes right of #18 green. Service yard left of #3 fairway. Right side of #17 from back tee to the second bridge.
- **PROTECTIVE FENCES:** All protective fences inside the course are considered immovable obstructions (Rule 24-2).
- **ROADS & PATHS:** All cart paths (dirt or artificially surfaced) are deemed immovable obstructions and relief may be taken under Rule 24-2, no penalty.
- **FLOWERBED:** A player may take relief from the flowerbed behind #8 green and the rose bed beside the tenth tee. (Nearest point of relief stance and swing no closer to the hole plus one club length.) No penalty.
- **STONES IN BUNKERS** are considered movable obstructions (Rule 24-1 applies).
- You are responsible for any injury to people or damage to property caused by your actions, including errant golf shots.

E.O. NAY COURSE #2 LOCAL RULES
USGA & The Following Local Rules Govern All Play

FLOOD CONTROL CHANNELS are LATERAL WATER HAZARDS. A ball coming to rest on the opposite side of a parallel channel is deemed to be in the channel. The concrete lining or a red line defines the boundary of the hazard.

NOTE: A ball may not be played from the channel.

LAKES: All lakes are lateral water hazards (Rule 26). Boundaries defined by the water's edge unless otherwise marked.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Fences and masonry walls bounding the course and the paved cart path behind #18 green. Defined by course side edge at ground level.

PROTECTIVE FENCES: All protective fences inside the course are deemed to be immovable obstructions (Rule 24-2)

DRAINAGE AREA: On #13 fairway (defined by posts and concrete walls) is considered an immovable obstruction. (Rule 24-2)

FLOWERBED: A player may take relief from the flowerbed behind #12 No penalty.

STONES IN BUNKERS: are considered movable obstructions (RULE 24 -1).

You are responsible for any injury to people or damage to property caused by your actions, including errant golf shots.

USGA Pace of Play is followed closely. Any group falling behind could be asked to move back one group.
