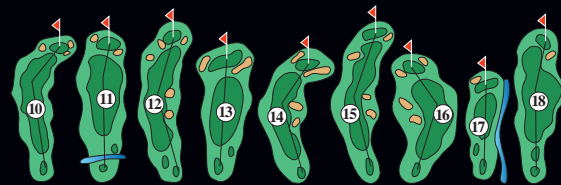
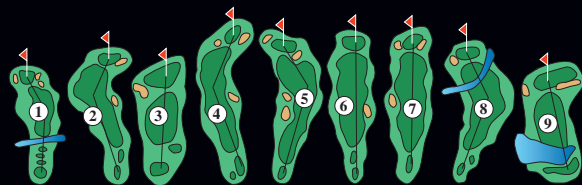

USGA RULES GOVERN ALL PLAY

LOCAL RULES:

OUT OF BOUNDS: All fences bordering golf course, driving range, and white stakes.

WATER HAZARDS:
Holes 1, 8, 9 and 11, marked by yellow stakes.

LATERAL WATER HAZARDS: Holes 2, 3, 8, 10, and 17, marked by red stakes. To the right of the maintenance road on Hole 13.

OBSTRUCTIONS: Protective fences on holes 2, 7, and 8, Power Line tower on hole 5. All paved and unpaved cart paths. All concrete ditches not marked by red (lateral) or yellow (water) stakes (Ball to be dropped at point of entry). All staked trees. All flower beds.

RELIEF FROM OBSTRUCTIONS: Nearest point of relief stance and swing only, not line of sight.

POWER LINES: Ball striking power lines **MUST** be re-played without penalty.

RESTROOMS: Holes 5 and 13.

RULES:

- Registered players only. No caddies or spectators allowed.
- Players who, in any way, make themselves objectionable or fail to observe any of the course regulations will be denied the privileges of the golf course.
- No coolers allowed. All food and beverage must be purchased from the course.
- Each golfer must have his/her own clubs and bag.
- Maximum two players and bags per cart.
- No refunds and rainchecks.
- Please keep all carts and pull carts at least 30 feet from all tees and greens.
- The law provides that the golfer is responsible for injury or damage that results from their actions on the course and practice areas.
- The County of Los Angeles is not responsible for injury to player or damage to equipment and reserves the right to eject any player from the golf course or premises.
- For Banquets, call (909) 861-5757.
- You are responsible for any injury to people or damage to property caused by your actions, including errant golf shots.
